

Core Novice Vocabulary List

(First Edition, 2009)

Purpose: This is an attempt to provide a comprehensive and fair list for all Novice players. As the methods of Latin instruction have diverged over the years into those that use the traditional approach and those that use the reading approach, much of the vocabulary used in the various courses has diverged as well. This list contains most of the important vocabulary words from the popular textbooks.

Much, if not most, of the vocabulary in the Novice language questions will come from this list. Thus, learning these words is not only educational but an excellent first step in preparing for the NJCL Certamen contest.

Method: Vocabulary from all of the popular textbooks was first compiled into a bulk list. These words were then given a rank based upon their frequency. Those that are found in most of the books were automatically included in the final list. Those words that are only found in one textbook, with few exceptions, were eliminated. Finally, a committee went through the words that are found in just a couple of textbooks on a word by word basis and decisions were made about each one. Notes: In addition to this list, students should also be aware of the basic vocabulary from Roman mythology, history, and daily life. This includes such items as the names of the important gods and goddesses, rooms in Roman houses and baths, occupations, the *cursus honōrum*, and basic colors.
